The islands' rich cultural history spans over 7,000 years. Malta's colourful history is reflected in its art, architecture and customs. The islands are

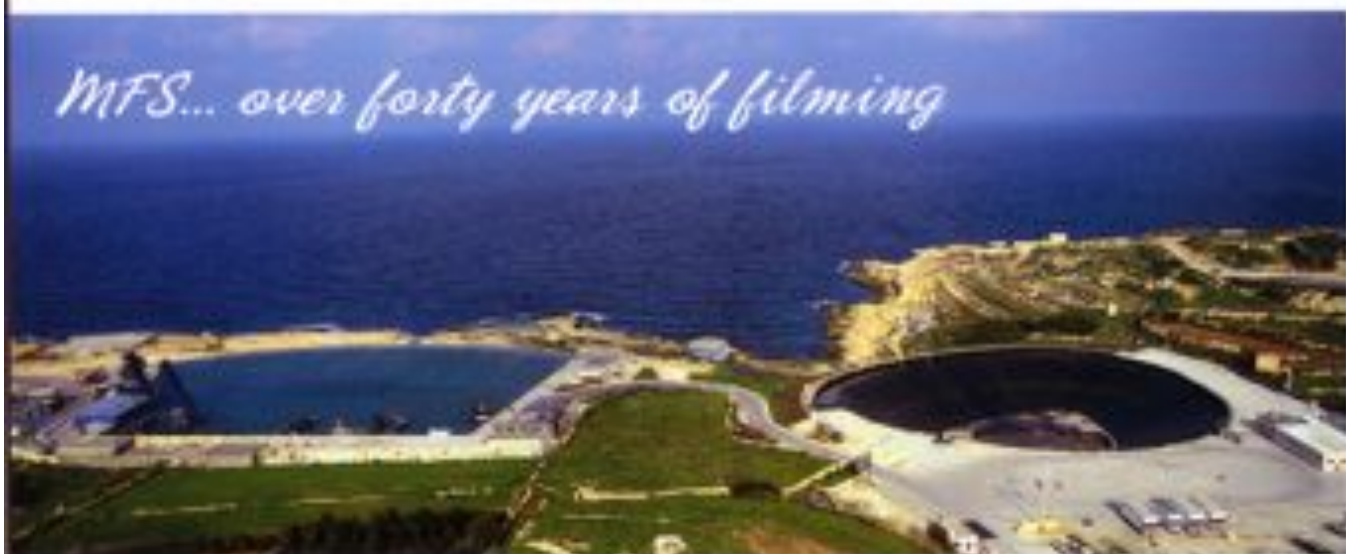
known for their temperate climate and the hospitality of their people.

MFS is not only renowned for its marine facilities and expertise, its experience to create a variety of pyro special effects and of course any form of marine SFX, but also for the skills of craftsmen building to your specifications almost any imaginable props or set.

As the productions grew bigger, so did the construction and SFX requirements. The film "Christopher Columbus: The Discovery" required the construction of three full scale period ships; two 'cannon firing' pirate ships were built for the mega budget film "Cutthroat Island"; and two

full scale replica World War II submarines were constructed for Dino De Laurentiis' "U-571" ...just to mention a few.

Ridley Scott's boat disaster "White Squall" features frighteningly realistic storm scenes that were created in the MFS Shallow Tank, using its wind, wave, smoke and rain machines as well as tip tanks and water shooters. Benigni's spectacular adaptation of the classic "Pinocchio" used MFS marine SFX equipment and expertise for their special effect shots in the shallow tank. As did countless other productions.

Pneumatic operated machines which if placed in a certain manner will create waves of maximum 1.30m high.

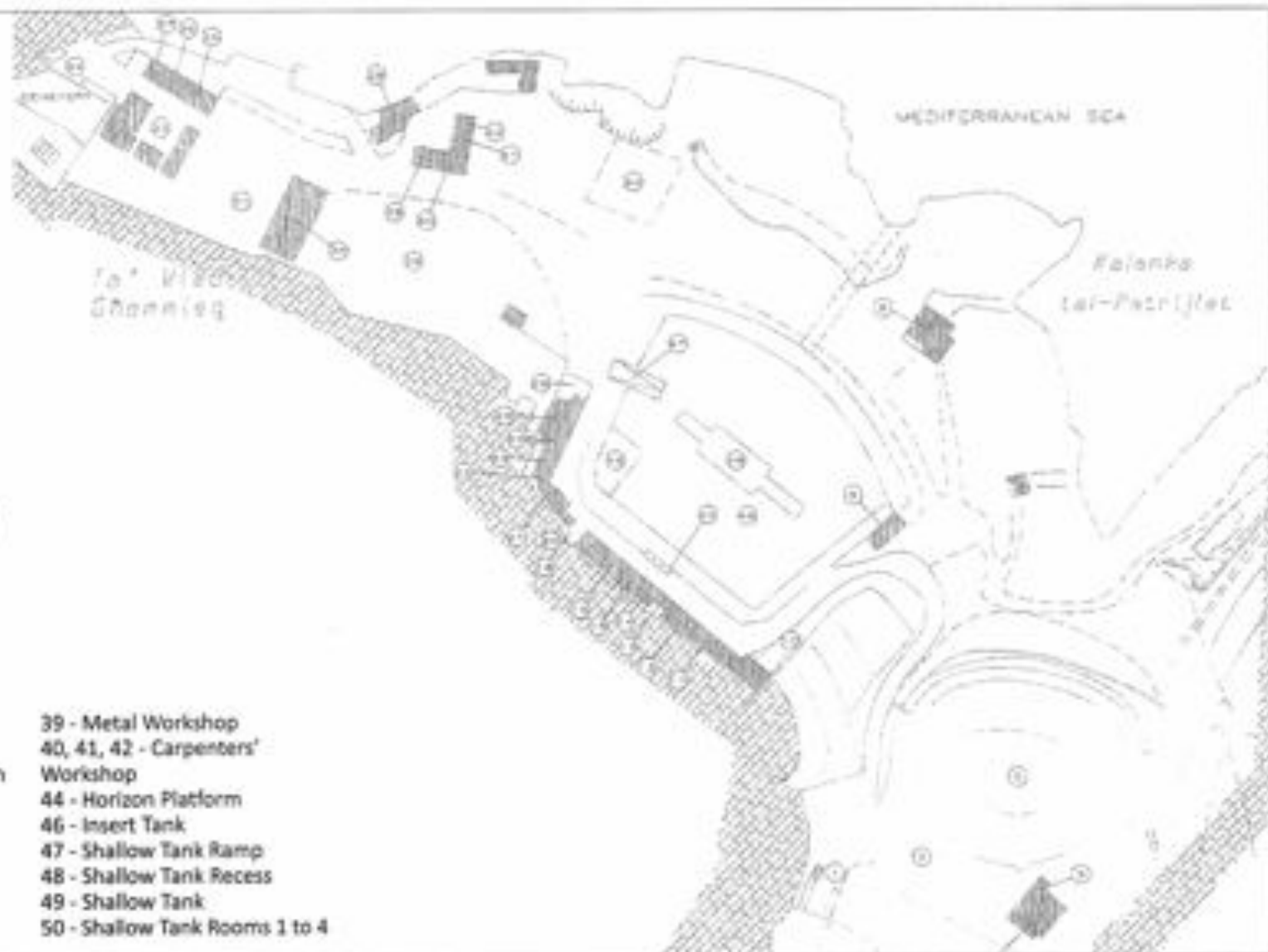


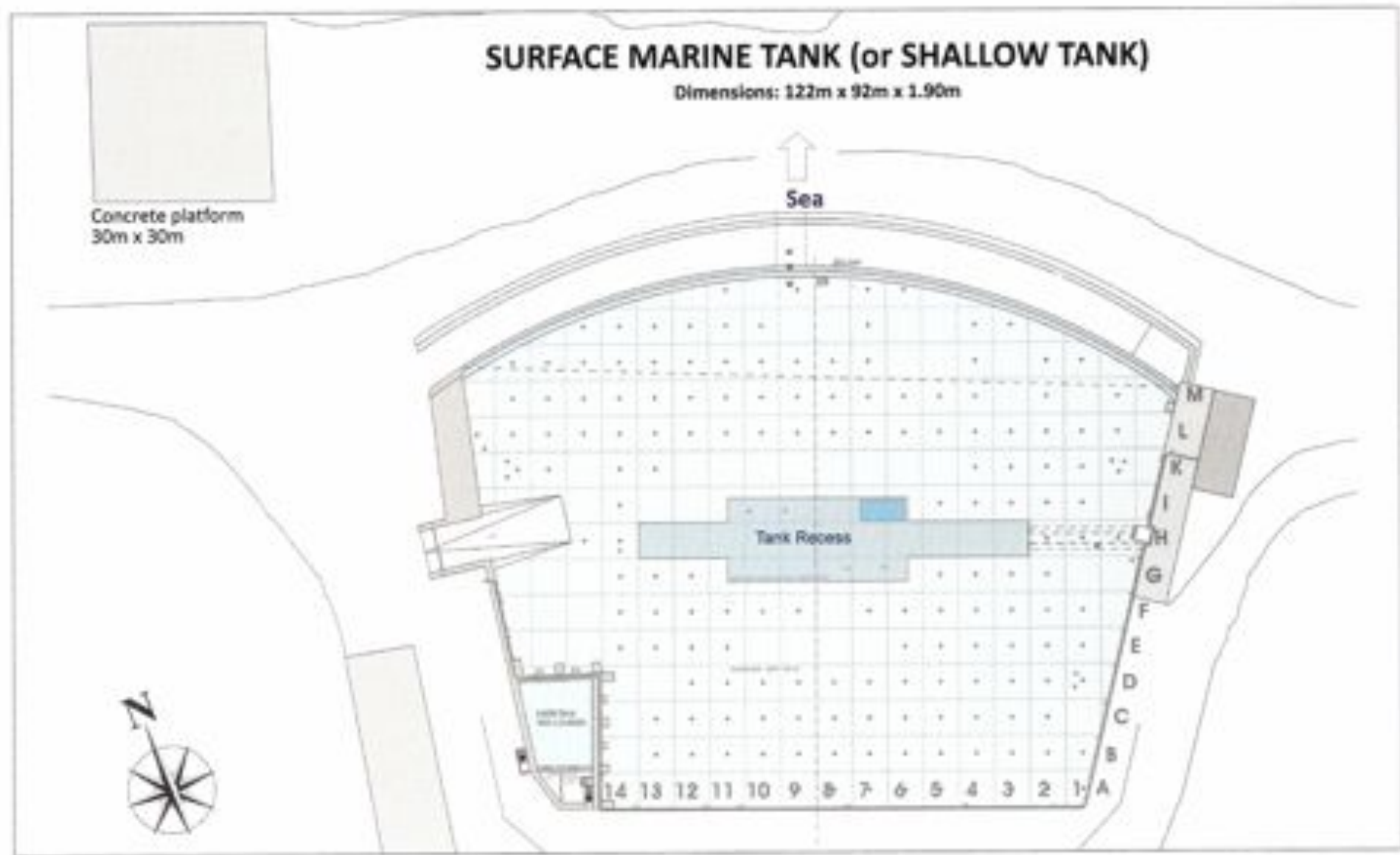

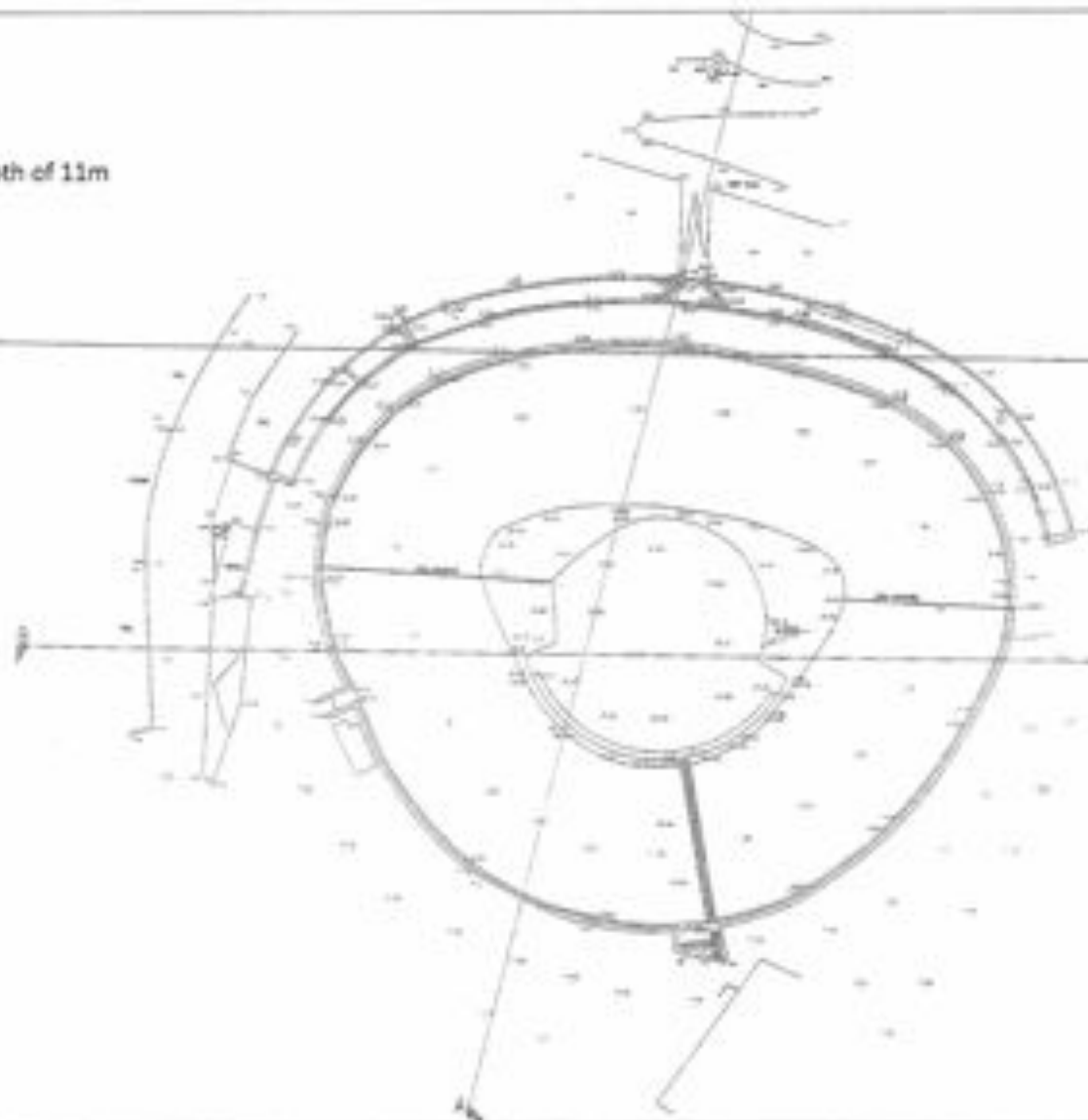
